PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This is a customized program for undergraduate students in STEM fields who will be completing a 3+1 program at UConn or are part of the Brazil Scientific Mobility Program (BSMP) and are continuing in the fall semester at either UConn or another university. Curriculum is designed for intermediate to advanced level learners who are preparing to enter an academic program.

The IEP curriculum emphasizes development of language learning strategies and self-directed learning. Innovative courses incorporate experiential, problem-based and project-based learning as well as in-class interaction with native English speakers.

COURSES

Students in the Intensive English Program will take five courses including three core skill courses and two electives. Core skill courses include Communication Skills, Reading Discussion, and Focus on Writing. Morning courses focus on building core language skills and academic English proficiency. Afternoon courses are content-based electives, which typically incorporate projects, presentations, field trips and guest speakers.

TOEFL PREPARATION AND TESTING

All students will have the option of taking a TOEFL Preparation course and take the paper-based TOEFL test that will be administered by UCAELI during the final week of the session.

STUDENT LIFE

Housing and Meals - Students will live in an on-campus dormitory in a double room. Roommates will be other UCAELI students from a variety of countries. All students living in campus housing are required to purchase a full meal plan. This plan allows for three daily meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) in any of the open campus dining halls. The campus dining halls offer a wide variety of food options including vegetarian, vegan, halal, kosher, and gluten-free. Students may also opt to purchase Husky Bucks, which is a cash balance on the student ID Card that can be used to purchase food from restaurants and food vendors on and near the campus. During the three-week period from August 8 to August 26, students will have a break before the fall 2016 semester begins. Housing and meals will be available on campus during the break between sessions.

Trips and Activities - A variety of trips and other social and cultural activities will be offered throughout the session. A full-day trip to New York City or Boston is included in the program fee. Additional optional Friday afternoon activities will include: museum trips, dinners or barbecues, outdoor recreational activities, shopping trips, movies, etc. Weekend trips to nearby places of interest will also be offered.
